First Year Scout's Advancement Schedule
January 2009 – December 2009

The following is a schedule of lessons to be given to the First Year Scouts by the Troop Guides or guest teacher. Each meeting date lists the name of the TG responsible for the lesson that night. The lessons should be about 15 minutes. The lesson will start right after the meeting opening and announcements. This will be around 7:15pm. After you have Explained, Demonstrated, Guided and Empowered the first year scouts with their new skill, at 7:30 they will have the opportunity to demonstrate what they learned to any Assistant Scoutmaster present at the Meeting. This will allow some time before the IPA to have the requirement signed off. Keep in mind that these times are only a guide. If more time is required, you can work up to the start of the IPA or the lesson can continue at the next meeting. When teaching a group of students, it is always good to have assistants. So even though you may not be responsible for a lesson you are expected to help if your fellow TG requests it. The page numbers listed by each lesson show where the information for that lesson is located in your Scout Handbook. Always use your handbook as a guide. From time to time, however, you will be given additional material to use as well. If you cannot make a meeting you are assigned to teach, it is your responsibility to find a substitute teacher. Mr. Simone or Phil needs to approve the substitute teacher.
