

# TROOP 778 COAL-TO-POWER PLUS DINNER

Meet at Stanton at 1:45.  
Depart Stanton at 2:00.  
Return to Stanton 7:30

The Troop will travel to the Ameren Power Plant in St. Louis County for a tour of both the outside coal operation and the inside power generation process. The tour will take approximately two hours. After the tour, we will travel to Hometown Buffet for dinner.

Cost for dinner: \$ 9.00. Each Scout is responsible for paying for his own meal.

#### Dress:

- Arrive at Stanton in boots, long pants (blue jeans are highly recommended) and a Scout T-shirt.
- If boots are unavailable, sturdy sneakers or shoes are absolutely required.
- Wear socks that extend above the top of your boots or sneakers.
- Bring your Field Uniform (shirt, neckerchief, slide only) on a hanger. Scout pants are not required.
- We will put on our Field Uniform shirts before leaving the power plant.
- Plan for the weather, especially rain and cold temperature.

Conditions at the power plant are dirty. Scouts are advised to not rub or lean against anything to avoid getting hard to remove coal dust on your clothes or person.

All Scouts must obey the tour guides throughout the entire afternoon. Pay careful attention to directions for moving from area to area, proximity to moving equipment, etc. All Scouts must exhibit Scout-like behavior at all times.

We will be sitting together at Hometown Buffet. Scout appropriate table manners will be expected throughout dinner. Scouts who begin dinner with desert will be looked at strangely and directed to start over.
