# CABIN CAMPOUT

**Richwoods, MO**  
**January 8 – 10, 2010**

Meet at Stanton at 6:00 on Friday, depart by 6:15.  
Return to Stanton at 12:30 on Sunday.

Cost: \$15.00 for food, due no later than the January 6 Troop Meeting.

Scouts should eat dinner Friday before arrival at Stanton. Snacks will be provided for Friday and Saturday night. Meals include breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday.

This is the annual cabin campout where Leaders purchase the food and prepare the meals. Patrol assignments will include clean-up for each meal, cleaning up the cabin a few times, and outdoor cleanup.

The cabin is divided into two sleeping areas (one for Leaders, one for Scouts) and has two wood stoves and a kitchen area. There are a few tables and chairs.

Scouts should bring a sleeping bag and pad (you will be sleeping on the concrete floor), plate, cup and utensils. Bring boots for outdoor activities and sneakers for indoors. Plan for cold weather and dress accordingly.

The Buddy System will be in effect the entire weekend.

Each Patrol is allowed to bring one board game. Chess and checker games will be provided from the Troop. Decks of cards are discouraged. The SPL will coordinate who brings what games. Game times will be after dinner cleanup until 11:00 pm each night. Lights out at 11:30.

A religious service will be held on Sunday morning. A short service project will be conducted on Saturday afternoon.

Activities on Saturday will include outdoor events and working with the 1<sup>st</sup> Year Scouts on advancement to Scout Rank.

The cabin is located on 80 acres of wooded land. There is a location for an outdoor campfire if the weather permits. Each Patrol should spend some time on Saturday preparing a skit that can be performed either indoors or outdoors.



The number of Scouts and Webelos attending may exceed the sleeping capacity of the cabin. If this occurs, Boy Scouts will be expected to demonstrate their ability to sleep outside in cold weather. We may set up one of the dining flies to create a mass sleeping area. Final decisions will be made on January 6.
