

TROOP 778 CANOE TRIP AND CAMPOUT



**September 23-25, 2011
Current River
Jadwin, MO**

Meet at Stanton at 5:30 pm on the 21st. Leave Stanton at 6:00 pm.
Return to Stanton between 12:00 – 12:30 pm on Sunday.

Transportation Cost: \$5.00, payable in cash only on September 21.

Cost Per Person: \$ 23.00 (\$19.00 for half of a canoe + \$ 2.00 per night for camping). Pay with cash, a check payable to Troop 778, or with your Scout account. Payment and the attached permission slip are due no later than September 21.

We will travel to Jadwin Canoe Rental on Friday night and set up camp. We're being transported to Cedar Grove, canoeing to Akers Ferry, and being transported back to Jadwin on Saturday.

Meals: Patrols should plan for either a cooked or non-cooked breakfast on Saturday morning. Each Patrol is responsible for their lunch and drinks while on the river. Store-made sandwiches are not permissible. Be sure to have a cooler with a latch for food and drinks. Plan a good, cooked dinner for Saturday night and a non-cooked breakfast Sunday morning. All menus must be approved by the SPL or ASPL at the September 21 Troop Meeting. Menus must be submitted no later than 7:00 PM for approval.

Scouts should bring clothing for the river, including old tennis shoes, hat, rain gear and a jacket if the weather is cool. Sun screen is strongly recommended while canoeing. All Scouts must have dry clothes to put on after canoeing, including boots or shoes.

Scouts who have passed the BSA swimmer's test will be allowed to canoe together. Non-swimmers will canoe with an adult. There will be opportunities to swim while on the river. Scouts will be expected to stay out of the water unless two or more adults are present and permission has been given. All Scouts will be expected to follow the directions of any adult, the SPL and the ASPL during the canoe float.



Fishing is okay during the canoe trip.
Bring your own fishing gear, and a valid
Missouri fishing license if you are 16 or over.
