Scouts should arrive at Beaumont no later than 6:30 pm on the 7th.
Scouts must be picked up from Beaumont between 10:30 -- 11:00 am on the 9th.

Patrols should plan for a cooked breakfast (quick) on Saturday, a non-cooked lunch and a good dinner that can be completed, including clean up, in less than two hours.. Plan for a cooked or non-cooked breakfast on Sunday. All Patrols should pay attention to the schedule for meals in the PACAO manual.

Scouts must bring a full uniform (on a hanger) for the Opening, Closing and Religious Services.

The gateway is being provided by the Stapletons. Scouts are expected to help set it up Friday evening and take it down on Sunday.

Patrols must participate in as many of the activities on Saturday as possible. Some preparation is required, and in some cases Patrols are responsible for bringing their own materials. All Scouts are expected to demonstrate spirit, enthusiasm and a positive attitude during the day. Extra points will be given for strong Scout behavior and deducted for un-Scout-like behavior. Have enthusiastic fun and demonstrate great teamwork and the points will build up.

Patrols should study the PACAO manual and practice in advance for those events that can be practiced. At least three of the events can be practiced (knots, rescue carries, etc.) and some of the others can be studied in an effort to improve results. Remember – a positive attitude and great Scout behavior helps improve the points in each event.
