The Memorial Day Good Turn provides an opportunity for all Scouts to show their respect to the men and women who have served the United States in the Armed Forces. The graves of over 150,000 veterans are located in the Cemetery.

Scouts must be in their most complete uniform. Be prepared for the weather. Watch the forecast and bring rain gear and hats, if necessary. Good walking boots are strongly recommended. Everyone must have at least one full water bottle.

We are assigned to Area 13 in the Cemetery. We will gather for the procession at Sign 10 in the Guard Base. Parents and siblings are welcome to attend. All adults not in uniform must have a picture ID. Scouts with a driver's license must bring them.

We will park next to Sylvan Springs Park and walk to the National Guard base for the procession and ceremony. After placing the flags on the graves, we will walk to return to our vehicles. Directions to our parking area will be provided at Stanton on the 29<sup>th</sup> and sent out to parents in the Troop 778 ENews.

Scouts and families who wish to place a flag on the grave of a relative should know the location of the grave in advance. Restroom facilities will be restricted to emergency situations. Scouts should plan ahead.

The procession to the ceremony will be in silence. All Scouts are encouraged to be patient and pay attention to what is happening around them.
