Meet at Stanton at 5:45 PM. Depart no later than 6:00 PM.  
Return to Stanton at 12:00 on Sunday.

The Troop may send an advance party to the Ranch on Friday to secure a suitable camping spot. Look for the sign for Gravois Trail as you drive past the Camporee Field when you arrive.

Meals: Candidates and Brothers should eat before leaving home on Friday. Snacks will be provided on Friday and Saturday nights. Candidates will have breakfast and lunch on Saturday during their Ordeal. Brothers will eat at the campsite or at the work locations. All will have the dinner provided by the OA on Saturday, and a quick breakfast at the campsite on Sunday.

All Candidates and Brothers must have a pair of work gloves and any of the following tools: hand weed-whips, bow saws, strong garden rakes (not leaf rakes). Adults can bring chain saws and gas weed whips. Insect repellent is strongly recommended at the work sites. Everyone should have several bottles of water during the work day. Long pants are strongly recommended. Boots are a must.

All Candidates and Brothers must have a complete uniform (tan shirt with all patches, Scout pants or shorts, Scout socks, Scout belt, neckerchief, slide and good sturdy boots. Brothers must have their OA sash. Bring a hanger to keep your uniform neat and clean.

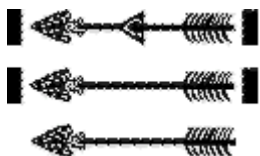
