# SPRING CAMPOREE

Meals: Saturday breakfast cooked, non-cooked lunch, cooked dinner; Sunday breakfast non-cooked. Lunch on Saturday will include the Pack 778 Webelos Scouts and adults. The Troop will purchase the food required for the Pack attendees; Patrols should plan and provide their own meals.

Proposed menus must be presented to an Assistant Scoutmaster no later than 7:00 pm at the April 27 Troop meeting for approval.

All Scouts must have their complete uniform, with their shirt, neckerchief and slide on a hanger, for the opening and closing ceremonies.

Patrols are responsible for preparing for all of the events on Saturday morning and afternoon. This includes bringing the required materials for each event that requires them and practicing for each event when possible.

Each Patrol should bring a contribution for the Troop Gateway. See the manual for ideas, and discuss them with the Senior Patrol Leader.

Scouts must be prepared for wet and perhaps cool weather. Boots are required. A pair of sneakers can be used in the Troop's camping area if the weather allows, but should not be worn to any of the events or activities.

Religious services will be held on Saturday evening from 6:30 – 8:00. All Scouts are expected to attend in full Class A uniform.



Scouts should remember that Webelos visits during Camporees and Pacaos are recruiting tools. Tents and Patrol areas should be neat and orderly during their visit on Saturday.

Spring Camporees and Fall PACAOs are excellent opportunities to watch other Troops in action, talk to their members, and look for new ideas and opportunities for our Troop.
