Campout



Beaumont Scout Ranch Shippey Field May 14 -16, 2010

Scouts should arrive at Shippey between 6:00 – 6:30 pm on Friday evening and arrange to be picked up no later than 11:30 am on Sunday. Scouts riding horses on Sunday morning must be picked up at Nagel Horse Ranch, Beaumont, at 12:00 noon on Sunday.

This campout combines several different activities:

- Saturday morning will be devoted to 1st Years Skills. All older Scouts will be expected to help.
- Saturday afternoon all Scouts will be divided into teams and will play Soccer, Ultimate Frisbee, Whiffle Ball and 500 in a round-robin format. Scouts should bring a ball glove for 500. All other equipment will be provided.
- Saturday dinner will be a Patrol contest. Dinners will be judged by the leaders for taste, creativeness, presentation and teamwork in both preparation and cleanup.
- Appalachian Trail participants will leave the campsite immediately after dinner to hike the Green trail and will camp Saturday night on the trail. They will return, if necessary, early enough on Sunday morning to ride horses.
- Scouts and adults signed up and paid for the horse ride will need to eat breakfast, pack their gear and take down their tent early on Sunday morning and be at Nagel Horse Ranch no later than 9:00 am.

Patrols should plan for a cooked breakfast, a non-cooked lunch and a great dinner on Saturday and a quick non-cooked breakfast on Sunday. Based on attendance, each Patrol will have their patrol box and all other trailer equipment.

Scouts should plan for warm to hot weather but be prepared for rain. Remember to bring protection from the chiggers and ticks. Any non-aerosol spray with Deet is highly recommended. Remember to bring a hat and sun screen.
